In Person: Bring your Enrolment Form to our office inside the Community Centre on Fulham Road.

After Hours: Place your completed Enrolment Form and payment details into the 'Comments Box' next to our office door.

Payment is required at the time of enrolling and to enrol you must be a member. A \$2.00 per annum (calendar year) fee is payable.

Enquiries are welcome at any time, although enrolments are not confirmed until payment has been received.

Confirmation of enrolment is assumed upon receipt of Course Fees.

Commencement of classes is subject to sufficient numbers; minimum and maximum numbers apply to all courses. In the event of class cancellations, all fees are refunded in full to your credit card or bank transfer.

Receipts: Receipts can be collected from the Office or from the class Tutor on the first day of class. Receipts will only be posted if a stamped self-addressed envelope is provided.

Cancellations

If a course is cancelled or delayed by RNLC, a full refund will be made available.

A refund will be made available if RNLC is notified in writing within **five business days prior to the commencement of the course.**

A \$15.00 administration fee is applicable

No Refunds are available after a course has started.

Refunds will be by bank transfer or credited back to your card.

Missed Classes:- Make up classes or a refund for missing a class will not be issued.
